SALIENT FEATURES OF HAJJ POLICY 2023 ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Hajj quota allocated to Pakistan for 2023 is 179,210. This shall be distributed between Government & Private Hajj Schemes at a ratio of 50:50 i.e. 89605 and 89605 respectively
- 2. Out of the Government and Private Hajj Schemes a quota of 44802 seats @ 50% each shall be reserved for Sponsorship Scheme
- 3. The remaining quota of Government Hajj Scheme shall be utilized for the traditional Regular Scheme
- 4. The Sponsorship Scheme is a facility of selection for Hajj without balloting for those intending pilgrims who can deposit their Hajj dues in foreign exchange remitted from abroad
- 5. The Sponsorship Scheme quota shall be utilized on first come first serve basis. (registration for the Sponsorship Scheme shall be stopped the movement the reserved quota is filled)
- 6. The foreign exchange secured through the Sponsorship Scheme shall be utilized for payment of the Hajj related dues to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia
- 7. For the year 2023, cost of Hajj Package (without Qurbani) for North region is PKR 1,175,000 and for South region PKR 1,165,000
- 8. There is no age limit for Hujjaj this year
- 9. The intending pilgrims who have performed Hajj within last 05 Hajj years i.e. 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2022 are ineligible for Hajj 2023 while intending pilgrims of Sponsorship Scheme are exempted from this bar
- 10. Applications of Hajj-e-Badal would be entertained provided such applicants for whom Hajj-e-Badal is performed have not performed Hajj under Government scheme for the last 05 years i.e. from 2016 and onwards
- 11. The selection for Regular Scheme of Government Hajj quota will be made through computerized balloting
- 12. A Place of Departure (POD) wise waiting list of Hujjaj comprising of only 0.5% of Government Hajj quota will be maintained
- 13. All the applicants are required to have CNIC and Machine Readable Passport with validity period till 26-12-2023
- 14. It is mandatory for the applicant to have Bank account
- 15. Special persons are required to be accompanied by helpers / attendants
- 16. 3% seats of the total seats under Government scheme shall be reserved for hardship cases

- 17. 300 seats shall be reserved for labour / low paid employees of companies registered with EOBI and Workers Welfare Fund. Their selection will be made through separate balloting
- 18. There shall be no provision in the policy for free Hajj
- 19. Immunization of approved corona vaccines by KSA is mandatory
- 20. Wearing of mask is compulsory during Hajj at closed and open places
- 21. It is mandatory for women to be accompanied by Mehram
- 22. In case of Mehram, repeaters (Male) who have performed Hajj within five Hajj years (2016 to 2022) will be eligible provided they apply with their family female(s) who have not performed Hajj within 05 years
- 23. All the Hujjaj will be provided five (05) litres of ZamZam
- 24. A comprehensive awareness campaign for training of Hujjaj is launched through print and electronic media
- 25. Hajj Medical Mission, Muavineen-i-Hujjaj, Seasonal staff of MORA & IH and KSA-based Muavineen-i-Hujjaj shall be deployed for facilitation / assistance of Hujjaj as per requirements and laid down procedure
- 26. "Road to Makkah" project facility will continue at Islamabad airport, it may be extended to Lahore and Karachi
- 27. This Ministry shall respond to queries raised by Hujjaj both in Pakistan as well as in KSA on daily basis
- 28. Place of Departure (POD) wise air load from major airports shall be distributed between local and Saudi airlines at 50:50 ratio. The air load from all PODs which is not utilized by the national carriers shall be distributed amongst other airlines which provide services from those airports
- 29. The HGOs will be monitored by the trained staff of the Ministry to ensure facilitation of Hujjaj by the HGOs as per the agreements
- 30. Hujjaj Mohafiz Scheme based on the concept of "Takaful" will continue
- 31. Service Provider Agreement will be signed with the HGOs for assurance of facilitation of Hujjaj
